

New Grafton Correctional Centre

The NSW Government is funding a new correctional centre in Lavadia, approximately 12.5 kilometres south of Grafton. The new facility will accommodate 1,700 inmates and will be the primary correctional facility for all correctional operations between the Queensland border in the north, Kempsey in the south-east and Tamworth in the south-west.

In March 2017, the Northern Pathways consortium, comprising of Serco, John Laing, John Holland and Macquarie Capital, was appointed as the preferred proponent to design, construct, operate and maintain the new Grafton Correctional Centre, on behalf of the NSW Government, for the next 20 years.

Stage one planning consent was also received in March 2017 and we are now preparing the stage two planning application.
